JOB SUMMARY

Youth Workers/Counselors play a critical role in Seattle Formosan Christian Church's youth ministry ranging from middle/junior and high school students. These leaders provide guidance, mentoring, and direction to students as they grow in spiritual and intellectual maturity. As leaders, they must be committed to growing in their own faith; they must also demonstrate a servant's heart and a concern for sharing wisdom. Leaders regularly meet with students in large- and small-group contexts, and they are called to walk alongside students and help them in the spiritual, practical, and intellectual complications that accompany adolescence.

TERM OF SERVICE

A part time female youth worker/counselor is to serve at least one year terms, with their primary commitments taking place during the academic (September–June) year.

MINISTRY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Consistently attend Saturday Youth Group and Sunday worship service.
- Participate in monthly EM Co-worker meetings.
- Participate in monthly youth student leadership team meetings.
- Provide guidance and leadership to middle/junior and high students alongside with the EM pastor and the other youth worker(s)/volunteers.
- Build relationships with students, especially girls, recognizing opportunities for discipleship, teaching, and spiritual growth.
- Plan and cast overall vision and curriculum for the youth group with other youth worker(s)/volunteers.
- As you are able, attend important events in the lives of your students (performances, competitions, and other ceremonies).
- Help the EM pastor organize and lead special events and worship gatherings.
- Organize special events and take the youths to conferences/retreats/special outings if necessary.
