<sup>11</sup> Whoever heard me spoke well of me,

**Psalm 58**

<sup>1</sup> Do you rulers indeed speak justly?  
Do you judge people with equity?  
2 No, in your heart you devise injustice,  
and your hands mete out violence on the earth.  
3 Even from birth the wicked go astray;  
from the womb they are wayward, spreading lies.  
4 Their venom is like the venom of a snake,  
like that of a cobra that has stopped its ears,

5 that will not heed the tune of the charmer,  
however skillful the enchanter may be.
